



PRIMARY TEACHER-LIBRARIAN ROLE

The Primary Teacher-Librarian is a member of the Calthorpe Resource Centre team operating in a K-12 environment and is responsible for working with Early Learning and Primary staff to teach student information literacy skills and to encourage students develop a love of literature.

The Primary (K-6) Teacher Librarian will -

- Foster lifelong learning and a passion for reading promoting Literature that reflects a wide variety of themes and cultures
- Collaboratively plan, teach and evaluate dynamic literature and information literacy programs
- Collaborate closely with the Head of Resource Centre to ensure that Resource Centre programs are consistent and sequential in the K-12 context of Marymede Catholic College
- Work collaboratively with the Primary Literacy Coordinator and teachers in curriculum planning ensuring integration of information literacy skills, library resources and technologies into student learning
- Develop and implement strategies for evaluating the digital and print collections for determining curriculum and student and staff needs
- Perform routine library tasks such as shelving, and circulation as required by the Head of the Resource Centre

The Person

- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills with students and teachers
- Possess the knowledge, experience and passion for teaching and children's literature
- Experience in working with physical and digital collections, including school library policies procedures, programs and systems
- Demonstrate a commitment to Professional Development and life-long learning

Key Selection Criteria

- Possess VIT registration along with relevant tertiary qualifications in librarianship
- Be eligible for membership to the Australian Library and Information Association
