FACILITIES OPEN

1. CHAPEL OF THE ANNUNCIATION

The 'Chapel of the Annunciation' constructed in 2009 is a truly significant building which is regularly used for Masses, Sacramental workshops, Staff Prayer and other liturgies. As the 'heart' of the College, it plays an integral role in Catholic Identity of the College.

2. CALTHORPE RESOURCE CENTRE

Named after Sr. Beth Calthorpe, President of the Association of Delegated Canonical Administrators, our Resource Centre provides a welcoming hub of information and learning resources. The Calthorpe Resource Centre is open to all students at 8.00am every morning and 4.30pm every afternoon. It is also open to Marymede students during Term holidays and allows them to access the latest digital and other resources for 21st Century learning.

3. FITNESS CENTRE

Shared by both Primary and Secondary students, our Fitness Centre consists of two full sized Basketball/ Multipurpose Courts, two general purpose Physical Education classrooms and a fully equipped Gym. Students use this space for their timetabled P.E classes and many sporting events which occur throughout the year.

4. PERFORMING ARTS AUDITORIUM

Our Performing Arts Auditorium provides the perfect hub for all Performing Arts and Music related activities and classes. Our theatre is used for Drama classes, special events and the Co-curricular Program, whilst our Instrumental Music classrooms hold state of the art technology and equipment which affords all stduents the opportunity to immerse themselves in a world of music.

5. SECONDARY SPECIALIST CENTRE

The Secondary Specialist Centre contains state-of-the-art technology throughout and comprises of three Visual Art labs, one IT/Media lab, two Science labs, two general purpose classrooms and one Music theory classroom.

6. FOUNDERS' BUILDING

The Founders' Building is comprised of seven general purpose classrooms used by Secondary School students.

7. VCE WING

The VCE Wing is used for Secondary School classes and special events, comprising of ten general purpose classrooms and one Media lab.

8. OUTDOOR SPORTING FACILITIES

Sport plays a major role in the life of our College. Marymede students from Prep to Year 12 make use of state-of-the-art sporting facilities which include our two Ovals, our synthetic turf Soccer Pitch and external basketball/multi-purpose courts.

9. DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY SPACES

Our wide range of elective subjects are housed across multiple design and technology spaces which include a textiles lab, woodwork lab and two food technology kitchens in addition to multiple art classrooms.

10. PREP HOUSE

Our standalone Prep house allows our new Prep students to thrive in their foundation year without feeling overwhelmed or anxious. Each classroom makes use of large interactive whiteboards and and outstanding resources, ensuring all students have the opportunity to achieve excellence.

11. PRIMARY SCHOOL COURTYARD

Often referred to as the 'central hub' of the Primary School, this courtyard is surrounded by three classroom blocks and our Primary School administration office. Currently, students in Years 1, 2 and 3 make use of the classroom blocks in this area.

12. PRIMARY SCHOOL SCIENCE LAB

The Primary School Science Lab allows our Primary students to immerse themselves in a world of integrated studies. Students will use this specialist classroom on a regular basis to conduct experiments and complete projects.

13. ST MARY'S COLLEGE FOR THE HEARING IMPAIRED

St Mary's College is a registered special school for hearing impaired students in Prep to Year 12. Students have the best of both worlds with the opportunity to learn alongside their hearing peers while being supported by Specialist Teachers of the Deaf. St. Mary's students wear the Marymede uniform and are completely involved in the life of the College.





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
