Term 4 has now concluded and we look forward to the 2015 school year with great enthusiasm. Below are some important updates regarding matters at Marymede Catholic College.

Communication

2014 saw a number of exciting new communication methods introduced into the College.

During Term 4 we introduced both Care Monkey and our Parent Access Module (PAM) into the College Community.

Care Monkey allows families to manage their child's health, wellbeing, medical and emergency details online whilst sharing them with the College to ensure that each record remains valid and up-to-date. Care Monkey was well received by the Parent Community and we look forward to its continued use throughout 2015.

The Parent Access Module (also known as PAM), provides each family with unique login details allowing Parents to log in to the Module and access important information relating to each of their children's education. Timetables, upcoming events, daily messages, learning areas, attendance data and Academic reports can all be accessed via PAM. Most recently, all students Semester 2 Academic reports were released through PAM, however, families can also access previous year reports as well.

Additionally we continued to use a number of communication methods such as emails, posted letters, telephone calls, SMS messaging, the College website and the College Facebook page to ensure all communication between the College and its families remains effective and efficient on a day-to-day basis. In most cases, email remains the preferred method of communication, and therefore we advise families to check their emails on a regular basis to keep up to date with correspondence from the College. Those without a valid email address submitted, will risk missing out on valuable news and information.

Facilities Update

Term 4 saw the completed renovation and upgrade to all Primary School Courtyard bathroom blocks. Each bathroom was fitting out with new basins, toilets and hand-dryers, as well as an upgrade to doors and the general design of each bathroom.

Throughout January 2015, works will commence on the re-surfacing of the decking area surrounding the Primary School courtyard, which is anticipated to be completed by the commencement of Term 1, 2015. Over the summer holidays the College will also install a new relocatable classroom block which will be used to house further Design & Technology classroom spaces.

Additionally, development of the new College Master Plan commenced during December 2014. The College anticipates the new Master Plan to be completed by the conclusion of Term 1, 2015. We look forward to welcoming student, staff and parent input into the new Master Plan as we endeavor to ensure that all students continue to be provided with a complete education in the best educational environment possible.

The 2014 School year ended on as strong a note of faith as it started. The Year 12 Graduation Liturgy and Ceremony were followed by Year level Masses in Years 7-9, at which Fr Maurie Cooney our chaplain gave the students memorable homilies around the theme of God's strong and constant love, and of doing their best with courage and faith. VCE Advent Liturgies brought to a close each of the VCE Orientation programmes for students in Years 11 and 12 in 2015.

Our Student Leadership Formation Day took place in early December and provided a wonderful opportunity for our 2015 leaders to reflect on a wide range of topics such as being responsible stewards of creation and believing in themselves to make a positive within the community around them.

Our Year 6 students celebrated their Sacrament of Confirmation on Sunday November 16 surrounded by family and friends at St. Patrick's Cathedral and their final year of Primary School concluded with a Graduation Mass and Ceremony taking place on Wednesday December 10.

The Years 7-9 Advent Liturgy provided a good opportunity to reflect on the Nativity theme "God so loved the world that he gave us his only Son, so that believing in him, we might have eternal life" (John 3"16), whilst the academic year was brought to a grand finale with events such as the Year 7 2015 Orientation Day (culminating in the Closing Liturgy), our New Staff Induction Day with a session on Teaching in a Catholic School, and the Staff End of Year.

Information Technology at Marymede Catholic College

During Term 4, the College Board approved a new 3 year Information Technology Plan, which will see further developments in IT resources to ensure that Marymede maintains the leading edge when it comes to technology.

During Term 1, 2015, students in Years 7, 10 and 11 will be provided with new devices, whilst all classes from prep to Year 2 will also be introduced to new devices that will be used in class on a daily basis. This is an exciting development at the College and one we look forward to with great enthusiasm.

Carols by Candlelight

On the evening of Thursday December 4, 2014, Marymede Catholic College hosted our inaugural 'Carols by Candlelight' in the College's Fitness Centre.

Planning for this evening's celebration began way back in June of this year and the success of the evening and the pleasure it brought to the students and audience can be attributed to the many members of staff who assisted in many different ways; a real group effort from dedicated staff, passionate about student involvement and the celebration of Advent.
