EXPRESSION OF INTEREST TO ATTEND MARYMEDE SNOW PROGRAM

The College is excited to announce that we are offering students from year 8-12 the opportunity to attend an extra-curricular, ski weekend at Mt Hotham this winter. To be considered to take part in this exciting program, students must display responsibility and endeavour in their studies and a history of involvement and participation in the full life of the College. The program will include two days of skiing or snowboarding (including lessons, hire and lift pass) at Mt Hotham, accommodation at Bright Chalet in Bright, all meals (including breakfast, lunch and dinner), supervision from Marymede staff and all coach transfers. The cost of this program is \$425.50, which will need to be paid upfront in securing your student's place and is cost is non-refundable.

WHEN: Friday 14th August departing at 4:00pm to Sunday 16th August, arriving back to College around 21:00pm

WHERE: Bright Chalet (Accommodation) and Mt Hotham Alpine Resort

COST: \$425.50

TRANSPORT: Private charter bus

ATTENDING TEACHERS Marymede Staff. All lessons will be instructed by trained professionals and students will be closely supervised by Marymede staff for the program's duration.

CONDUCT: All students will be exemplary in the way that they represent the College. Poor conduct will result in disciplinary action at the College.



UNIFORM: A full equipment list will be distributed once fees are paid.


