You will be required to book in a one hour session via PAM - You will receive a letter indicating your login and password.




RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

A Reading & a Writing Block in the morning (Ihr each)

Reading/Writing Block:

Whole class: teacher engages all students and presents a particular focus/skill

Whole class: Students come back together opportunity for students to share their learning
