Communication

We wish to remind all families about the importance of The Parent Access Module (also known as PAM). PAM allows parents to access important information relating to each of their children's schooling at any time. By now each family should have logged into PAM and familiarised themselves with its layout and functionality. This module will continue to be an important communication portal between the College and its families throughout the year. Bookings for our upcoming Semester 1 Progress Interviews are to be made via PAM, and Semester 1 reports will be released online through the module later in Term 2. Timetables, upcoming events, daily messages, learning areas, and attendance data can also be accessed through the service. The Parent Access Module is currently best viewed on a laptop, PC, or tablet device and is not compatible with smart phones.

It is also important for all families to check their emails regularly to ensure that they do not miss out on valuable news and information sent out by the College.

Should you have a change in contact details such as home address, phone numbers or email address, please contact the Main Office on 9407-9000 to submit the new information, alternatively you may also wish to email the change to registrar@marymede.vic.edu.au. Additionally, any family who changes their email address via PAM will also need to contact the Registrar to submit the new address to the College. Maintaining current contact details is essential to ensure that communication to and from the College remains possible and efficient.

Facilities Update

The have been some exciting developments regarding facilities at Marymede Catholic College throughout Term 1. At the commencement of the Term our new Design & Technology Lab was completed and is now holding classes on a daily basis. This space has been well received by our student cohort.

Catholic Identity:

Term 1 was an extremely exciting one for Marymede Catholic College in the area of spiritual life and Catholic Identity. In the Way of Mary, our senior and middle leadership embraced the servant leadership of Christ, as the model for leadership at all levels at our College. The Opening of the 2015 School Year Mass which included the commissioning of our new Principal Mr Michael Kenny was a highlight of this term. Busy weeks followed with the Ash Wednesday Liturgy and highly successful Year 12 Retreat. "From Crib to Cross" the Lent Liturgy preparing us for Holy Week and the Year 11 Justice Awareness Day has brought to an end, a robust term in which we have focused on what it means to be a Catholic school formed in the Way of Mary for discipleship of Christ.

Whilst Term 1 has also seen Primary classes unpacking the 2015 College Theme, "Let us love not only in word or speech but in truth and action." (1 John 3:18) and making connections to their lives, this journey will continue throughout the school year. The Lenten Season was started with Primary Classes participating in intimate Year Level liturgies in the Chapel of Annunciation to celebrate Ash Wednesday. Year 5 and 6 students and teachers were thrilled to be invited to the Lent Liturgy 'From Crib to Cross' with the Secondary Students. Primary classes are looking forward to many more linkage initiatives planned for the year. Fr. Martin Ashe, the Year 6 classroom teachers and the Primary Head of Faith and Mission welcomed families and Year 6 Confirmation Candidates to join in a workshop in preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation. The night was a great success.

Bell Times in 2015

During Term 1, the College made the decision to extend the Secondary School timetable by 7 minutes to ensure that we meet the minimum requirement of 300 minutes per day of face-to-face teaching time. This has now resulted in the Secondary students finishing each day at 3.10pm.

Enrolments

In Term 1 the College held its second round of Year 7 2016 enrolment interviews. Offers for places in Year 7 2016 will be mailed to families on Friday April 24. The demand for places at Marymede Catholic College is strong and continues to grow. Our College continues to be a leading provider of education in the Northern suburbs. Marymede adheres to enrolment policies set out by the Catholic Education Office Melbourne. Prep 2016 applications are also open and will close on May 15 2015.

School Bus

The College is again running 3 bus routes in 2015 which travels through the suburbs of South Morang, Mernda, Doreen, Whittlesea and Kinglake. This bus service continues to be popular among students and is an effective way of ensuring that our students arrive to school on time each morning and have a transport method available to them each afternoon should it be required.

In Term 2, the cost of a full Bus Pass (Term 2 ONLY) will be \$400 per child. The cost of a one way Bus Pass (Term 2 ONLY) will be \$235 per child. Casual passes will still be available subject to availability at a cost of \$4 each way. Any student without a valid paid in full bus pass (either full or casual) will not be permitted onto the bus under any circumstances.
